Winter Wheat	Winter wheat shall be sown by November 1 of each crop year and designated legume seeding shall be performed in early spring. This may be accomplished either by conventional means or in conjunction with Nitrogen top-dressing of the wheat acreage. If weather and field conditions do not permit fall wheat seeding, Vendor will be required to substitute oats and legume the following spring. This provision also applies to carryover wheat seeding in the last year of the executed lease. Wheat stubble (after harvest) must be left at a minimum of 10" in height for wildlife cover. 	<p>lbs. of Ladino clover. Vendor must provide receipts of legume seeding to the Site Superintendent. Vendor will bale stubble legume mix after August 16 and before September 15 of the year of establishment. Vendor does not pay additional rent on the legume acres in the establishment year, as the Vendor already is paying rent on those acres with the wheat acreage that the legume was seeded into in the spring. On the second year the vendor will bale fields labeled "Legume" before May 15th and <b>MAY</b> bale a second time between August 16 and September 15. In the years where the crop is listed as "Legume", the Vendor shall pay rent and taxes on those acres according to the bid price. Spot mowing of legume acres to control weeds may be required at the discretion of the DWB and Site Superintendent. Vendor shall be allowed to deduct the mowing expense from rental payment using the UofI Extension rates located at <a href="http://www.farmdoc.illinois.edu/Manage/">http://www.farmdoc.illinois.edu/Manage/</a> to determine the value of the deduction. Vendor will have the option to burn legume or wheat stubble fields on or before April 30 of crop year the acreage is to be returned to the rotation.</p>				
Field Borders	<p>All field borders are to be maintained at 33 ft from the high point of the ditch on the field edge and wildlife corridors are to be maintained at 66 ft. These areas are not to be used for roadways or turn rows except for emergency access.</p>	2023-2026		No	N/A
Fire Breaks	<p>Establishment of any firebreaks will be the Vendor's responsibility. Vendors should prepare firebreaks around all fields to be protected. This is a necessity due to the number of native grass areas that will be burned each year. The Vendor will have the option to prepare the firebreaks either in the fall or before burning begins in the spring.
